Your Accommodation

Moselle Valley - We stay four nights on half board basis at the 3* Landhaus Krähenest in Löff (or similar). The hotel overlooks the Moselle Valley with views of the river below and is an ideal base for our tour. Facilities at the hotel include a restaurant and a bar and all rooms are en suite.

Oberammergau - We stay two nights in Category 1 to 3 accommodation in inns/guesthouses in and around Oberammergau. Dinner and breakfast is included for each night's stay and lunch is included on the day of the Play. The availability of single rooms in Oberammergau is extremely limited and, once any availability is used up, those requesting single rooms will be accommodated in Oberammergau on a twin share basis.

Day 1 UK to Moselle Valley

We take our scheduled flight from London to Frankfurt (regional flights available on request – please call) where we are met by our tour manager who will accompany us throughout our tour. Transfer in our private executive coach to the 3* Landhaus Krähenest Hotel (or similar) in Löff overlooking the Moselle Valley for a four night stay on half board basis.



Day 2 Koblenz & Cochem

This morning our optional guided tour of Koblenz, the largest city on the Rhine, takes in sights such as the 12th century Church of Our Lady and the magnificent Kurfürstliches Schloss, one of the most beautiful Renaissance buildings in Germany. We then travel on to the charming town of Cochem dominated by the Reichsburg Castle rising more than 330 ft above the River Moselle.

Day 3 Rhine Cruise, Bacharach & St Goar

We travel to Boppard this morning for our included scenic Rhine cruise to Oberwesel. We continue by coach to the historic town of Bacharach, located on the banks of the River Rhine and dating back to 923. We then continue to the 13th century castle of Burg Rheinstein, built to protect the Mainz territory against the unruly knights of the River Rhine. Time permitting we visit the Rhine village of St Goar, located on the most scenic stretch of this beautiful river.

Day 4 Trier

We spend the day in Trier, the oldest city in Germany. The city is home to the famous Porta Nigra, a huge and formidable mass of stone and the biggest Roman gateway north of the Alps, and the 12th century St Peter's Cathedral, containing many rich treasures including the so called 'Holy Undivided Robe' of Christ.

Day 5 Rudesheim & Oberammergau

We leave the Moselle Valley today and travel to Oberammergau. En route we stop at Rudesheim, famous for the Drosselgasse - a narrow cobbled alley full of inns buzzing with the sound of revelry - but also boasting the remains of the 1,000 year old Bromersburg Castle. We then check in to our allocated Category 1 to 3 inns and guesthouses in and around Oberammergau for a two night stay. Dinner is included this evening.

Day 6 Oberammergau Passion Play

This morning you may explore the village and visit the Oberammergau Museum. After an included 3 course lunch, we take our Category 2 seats for the Passion Play. The performance runs from 2.30pm until 10.30pm with a 3 hour break for an included 3 course dinner in a restaurant in Oberammergau.

Day 7 Oberammergau to UK

After breakfast in Oberammergau, we transfer to Munich Airport for our scheduled flight back to the UK.
